The Grossglockner High Alpine Road

(Großglockner Hochalpenstraße) is one of the world's most fascinating scenic roads and has been protected as a heritage site since 2015. Extending for 48 kilometres, it runs through the heart of the Hohe Tauern National Park up to 2,571 metres above sea level, passing the foot of **Austria's highest mountain** before finishing at **the longest glacier in the Eastern Alps**, the Pasterze.

Kaiser-Franz-Josefs-Höhe, at 2,369 metres elevation, reveals a one-of-a-kind lookout over the 3,798 m-high Grossglockner's mountainsides and snowy slopes, along with the other three-thousanders that surround it. Go for a short walk and you might catch sight of **marmots, or even ibexes, chamoises and eagles**. A variety of informative themed trails and interesting exhibits offer an unforgettable experience in nature.

GERLOS ALPINE ROAD



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The **Gerlos Alpine Road** is an important mountain pass road from Salzburg to Tyrol. Located in the western part of the Salzburg region of Pinzgau, the mountain road offers an opportunity to discover the alpine landscape between Krimml and the Tyrolean Zillertal. The best time to experience the

Alpine Road is in the months from May until the end of October. During the winter months, the Gerlos Alpine Road leads into the Zillertal Arena ski area. The absolute highlights on the mountain road are the **Krimml Worlds of Water and the Krimml Waterfalls.**

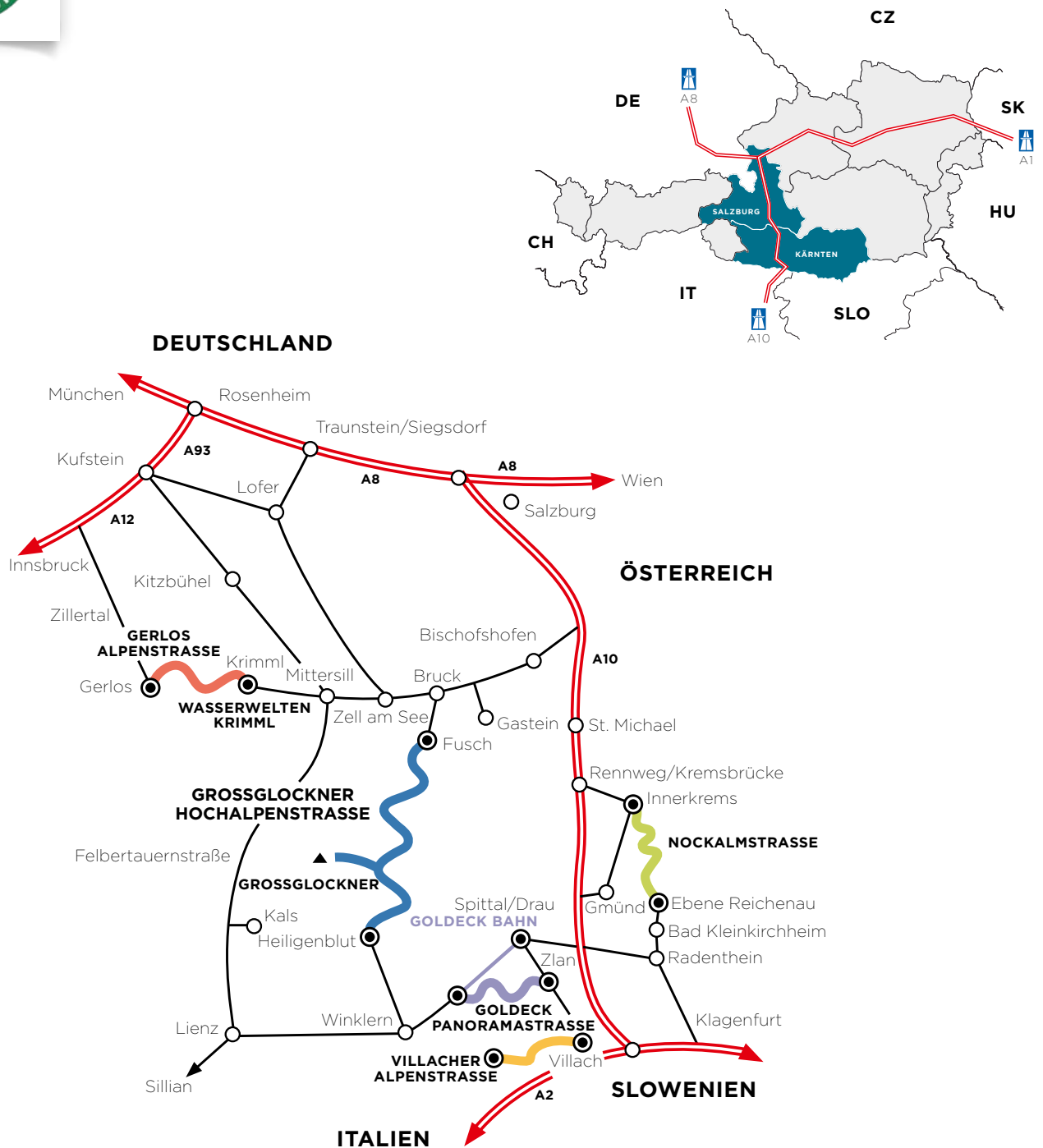
